## **Purpose of ITC Conference Grants**

# Conference grants are aimed to:

- support PhD students or Early Career Investigators (ECIs, <8 years after PhD) from ITC countries to attend conferences related to Bioimaging preferentially to correlated multimodal imaging in Life Sciences, not specifically organized by the COMULIS COST Action.
- Promote the spread of innovative correlative multimodal imaging in biomedical research and preclinical imaging.
- Increase researchers' visibility, networking and fostering collaborations on innovative correlated multimodal methods.

# **Eligibility criteria**

- PhD students or ECIs affiliated to a research institution in an ITC country.
- Target conference and candidate's contribution in scope with COMULIS goals/objectives.
- Target conference during the period 15<sup>th</sup> November 2018 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022.

### **Evaluation from the successful Grantees**

- Evaluation of the application by the ITC coordination committee. Scoring attributed to criteria such as:
  - o Contribution Quality
  - Candidate's CV (max.2-3 pages)
  - Conference quality/relevance/visibility

## **Expectations from the successful Grantees**

- Requisite: Candidate is listed in the conference program with an/a oral/poster communication to receive the grant (applications can be submitted before program confirmation, and evaluation can be performed beforehand).
- Grantee must provide a short conference report
- Grantee must contribute to official COMULIS website <a href="https://www.comulis.eu/">https://www.comulis.eu/</a> with new entries reflecting the conference program

#### **Conditions**

- Refund is made after the conference upon completion and submission of the Grantee conference report.
- Refund can be total or partial, and includes registration fee, travel, accommodation, and subsistence expenses.
- Conferences are preferred in Europe, but are not limited to Europe





### How to apply

- Fill in the <u>Application Form</u> and return it to the ITC-Conference-Grants Coordinator and Chair (see details in the form).
- Application is open for conferences happening from November 2018 to September 2022.

# **Eligible conferences**

 COMULIS does not restrict the range of conferences to a specific list. Any Conference dealing at least in part with Bioimaging and Image Analysis in Life sciences, preferably Correlated Multimodal Imaging, is eligible.

## **Inclusivness Target Countries (ITC)**

- ITC Conference Grants are exclusively reserved for *PhD students and early career investigators* (*ECIs*) with a primary affiliation in an institution located in an ITC.
- List of "ITC Countries": Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Republic of Serbia and Turkey.
